Reading

In Lesson 13 we will be sounding out words with the "sh," "wh," and "ph" digraphs as in *ship*, *when*, and *phone*. A **contraction** is a shorter way of saying two words. **Don't** is made from the words *do* and *not*. **It's** is made from the words *it* and *is*.
