details. At the end of each lesson we will have a test covering the sight words from the lesson, the phonetic skills introduced, and the content of the stories for the week. You can help your child study by reviewing the sight words and reading over the selections for the week. I will always tell you when a test is scheduled. We completed our first reading test today. Since this was our first reading test, we completed most of it together. I will send home the graded test early next week. In Lesson 2 we will be reviewing the short sound of /i/ as in inch. The test for Lesson 2 will be on Wednesday, September 9th.
