### Religion

### Memory Work

The assignment for the first week back after the Christmas break is the First Commandment.

### Math

2, 4, 6, and 8 are **even** numbers. When we add two to an even number, the sum is the next even number on the numberline -  $4+2=6$ . 1, 3, 5, and 7 are **odd** numbers. When we add two to an odd number, the sum is the next odd number on the numberline -  $3+2=5$ . Spend some time working on flashcards during the Christmas break!

### Science

Sound travels through the air in all directions.

### Reading

In Lesson 13 we have been sounding out words with the "**sh**," "**wh**," and "**ph**" digraphs as in *ship*, *when*, and *phone*. A **contraction** is a shorter way of saying two words. **Don't** is made from the words *do* and *not*. **It's** is made from the words *it* and *is*. The **test** for Lesson 13 will be **Friday, January 8th**.

### Spelling

There will not be a spelling unit the week we return from break. Our next test will be on Thursday, January 14th.

### Grammar

**Am**, **is**, and **are** are special verbs. We use **am** when talking about ourselves, **is** when talking about one other person or thing, and **are** when talking about more than one person or thing.
