## Arrival and Dismissal

### Dismissal

Please do not arrive at school until our dismissal time at 2:50 pm to help alleviate traffic congestion.

Groups of students will be dismissed in five minute intervals so please leave as soon as it is safe to do so.

Parents should get out of their cars with their car tag and remain on the sidewalk in front of their car once they see their child's teacher exit the building.
