6th Grade

Math

It has been great to get to know the new Middle Schoolers and test them with some previous knowledge. We will get started in the book next week with Lessons 1-5 and our first test on Friday, August 27th.

Science

We have been working through chapter one of our online Glencoe Science book, "The Nature of Science" We will continue this into next week.

Social Studies
